Eye Splice for Brait (8-Strand Plaited Rope)

Eye Splice for Brait (8-Strand Plaited Rope) Yale Cordage, Inc 2004 Purpose: These instructions detail the procedure to fabricate an eye splice in Yale's Brait products or any suitable 8-strand plaited rope An eye splice is a permanent loop termination that maximizes the opposing strand direction in the braid In this way the strands of

reference 8-strand ropes are composed of 4 pairs of 2 strands each 2 of the strand pairs rotate to the left, and 2 pairs rotate to the right When marking the left-rotating strands, be sure to turn the rope over and mark the left-rotating strands on the opposite side of the braid Turn rope over

Mystery Braid Cuff Project Summary: Step-by-Step Instructions (with pictures): 13 Make four turns of the braid, and then you will need to start untangling the bottom of the braid Take the strand furthest on the right and pull on it; this will bring the bottom tab of the bracelet
